Murwillumbah High School Special Education Unit 'Inspiring every student every day'

Murwillumbah High School Special Education Unit offers support classes for students with a disability. Enrolment is determined through a placement panel at the Regional Office.

The school has 6 support classes which offer both life skills curriculum and integration support for mainstream curriculum enrolment. The personalised learning and support needs of the student with disability is addressed through a collaborative planning process with students, parents and carers. Planning includes considering course options, reasonable adjustments and disability provisions for the HSC. Adjustments to learning enable equitable participation by students in the full range of education activities on the same basis as their peers without disability.

Students with disability can meet the requirements for the award of the HSC by undertaking a combination of Board developed courses. Board endorsed courses and/or stage 6 Life Skills courses.

Murwillumbah High School Special Education Unit provides a dynamic learning environment that engages and challenges students to reach high expectations. Each small class is able to provide intensive learning support to students from experienced and dedicated special education teachers and learning support officers. It is an environment that enriches and enhances every child's learning whilst preparing them for the world beyond school.
